






MOUNTING DIMENSIONS

I. INSTALLATION See page 2 & 3 for mounting

- 1. The support arm on the Base (1) should be positioned toward the bottom of the compartment, in both horizontal and vertical storage configurations.
- 2. It is suggested to place the mounts near the tool heads to allow for quicker and easier operation (as shown on page 1).
- 3. Attach Base to mounting surface using Truss Head Screws (5) combined with 1/4" nuts (6) and washers (8)(10). If longer screws are needed, use low profile truss head screws.
- 4. Adhere the Pad (9) to the flat portion of Base (see Page 2).

II. SECURING THE TOOLS (Shown above)

- 1.Place both tools together as shown on page 1 and secure together with the UMVS-0811-11(3) strap around the center of the handles.
- 2. Place and hold the tools against the Base. When in a horizontal configuration, the support arm may be used for assistance and stability.
- 3. Place the Strap (3) over the tools. Slide it behind the oval-shaped post from the side.
- 4. While maintaining tension on the strap, pull away from the Base to tighten, then connect the hook pad and the loop pad to secure.

III. REMOVING THE TOOLS FROM MOUNTS

- 1. Grab the end of the strap at the red tab and pull away from the base to release the hook & loop connection.
- 2. Pull the tool towards you, through the loosened strap. Strap will free itself as you pull.

IV. SEPERATE THE TOOLS (Page 1)

1. Grab the red tab of the UMVS-0811-11(3) strap, pull and release the hook and loop connection to remove the strap.
