The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed your request dated April 13, 2004. This request was for the model SR 510 P100 filter (p/n H02-1321) that can be utilized alone and in combination with the model SR 218-6, model SR 231, model SR 232 and model SR 229 cartridges on the model SR 200 full face mask and the SR 90 and SR 100 half masks. The approvals affected by this request are identified on the Full Face Mask Respirator Family Approval Matrix (200401FULLAM11.xls) and the Half Face Mask Respirator Family Approval Matrix (200401HALFAM11.xls).

This request is granted. Approval is granted for English language only on all documentation. It is the manufacturer's responsibility to correctly translate materials desired in languages other than English.

The diskette enclosed with this letter contains the final cartridge, filter and respirator approval labels for this submission. The cautions and limitations which apply to these approvals are on the approval labels. Only those assemblies affected by this request or where new approval numbers are assigned apply to this approval action. Production approval labels cannot include information on unapproved configurations.

The approved assemblies consist of the parts as listed on the approval labels plus the assembly matrices. Parts are to be marked with the numbers indicated on the approval label in a legible and permanent manner (marking cannot be removed without evidence of its previous presence).
